## DOWNTOWN VENDORS APPLICATION

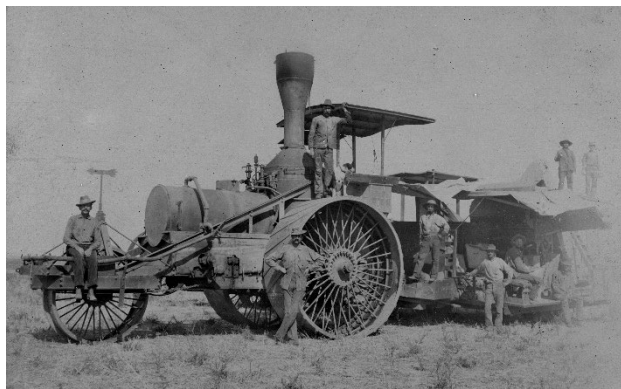
- 1 \_\_\_ The Pioneer Day Vendor Fair will be held on Saturday, June 1, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in Redinger Park.
- 2 \_\_\_ Vendors must check in by 8:00 a.m. DO NOT arrive or set up before. Vehicles must be removed from vendor area by 8:30 a.m.
- 3 \_\_\_ Booth size is 10'x10'. Vendors are responsible for providing own tables, chairs, garbage cans, pop up tents, decorations, generators, etc.
- 4 \_\_\_ There is NO ELECTRICAL ACCESS for any booth. Williams Pioneer Day Committee does not provide on-site electrical access. Vendors must provide their own generators. Generators must be safe and in good working order. Loud generators are not permitted. Vendors must bring their own extensions cords. Vendors may not plug into any city outlets. Any booth not conforming to this RULE will be asked to stop sales and conform. Any booth refusing to conform will be asked to leave.
- 5 \_\_\_ Booths are ONLY to be set up in designated areas.
- 6 \_\_\_ Extension cords are prohibited from trailing across pathways.
- 7 \_\_\_ Alcoholic beverages or any illegal substances are forbidden to be sold or consumed by vendors.
- 8 \_\_\_ Vendors are advised against the sale of public nuisance items such as fart bombs, silly string, noisemakers, air-horns, and shaving cream. Music will be provided during the event.
- 9 \_\_\_ Vendors must leave with their surrounding area clean.
- 10 \_\_\_ This event will be held rain or shine.
- 11 \_\_\_ All fees paid to the Citizens for a Better Williams are Non-Refundable and a portion of vendor fee will be donated to the CBW Scholarship fund and to Karen's House benefit.
- 12 \_\_\_ FIRE EXTINGUISHER REQUIRED. All booths using a generator or cooking device are REQUIRED to have an appropriate fire type extinguisher at their booth. WFD or Williams Pioneer Day Staff WILL be checking. Any booth not conforming to this RULE will be asked to stop sales and obtain an appropriate fire extinguisher. Any booth refusing to conform will be asked to leave. Please have your extinguisher available at the time of check-in for inspection.
